Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Private transfer from Jerez to Sevilla.

Arrive in Sevilla and check in at the 4 **** hotel; after settling in, we will enjoy the city of Seville, which has countless attractions that deserve to be visited.

Our adventure begins with a **visit to the Real Alcázar de Sevilla**, a majestic royal palace with a history that dates back to the early Middle Ages.
